 North North west on the land & adjacent her and then
 west & north west Twenty Acres west towards the Swift Creek
 then North North West Eighty Acres and then by the line
 Eastward to the head of the Ketchey run toward the
 Cotton being one hundred and fifty Acres and from thence
 South & South East for hundred & forty Acres to the place
 where it begins the head of the said Ketchey run
 Christopher Dejean & John Howard by and with the consent
 of Twelve persons into this thing for the love and to the
 good use and paying as which payment is to be made seven
 years after the first or better thereof and as before provided
 on the 25th of November 1720

 him for the said land & fifty Acres and by purchase of the
 said David H. Jones seven hundred and one Acres of land
 and to hold unto the said David H. Jones and his heirs forever
 seven years after the first or better thereof and as before
 provided on the 25th of November 1720

To all etc whereas etc Now Know yee that I the said Richard Bennett / Esquier give and grant unto CHRISTOPHER ROBINSON & John Sturdevant / Six hundred acres of Land lying and being in the County of / Henricoe and upon the heads of the Eastern run of the -- / Swift Creeke which run is known by the name of Mr Hatchers / run and bounded as followeth that is to Say from a Marked / tree on Mr Hatchers run west south west Eighty Chaines -- / towards the Swift Creeke Each Chaine Containing two pole -- / then North North west on the heads to a Marked tree and then / west South west twenty Chaine more towards the Swift Creeke / from thence North North west Eighty Chaines and then East North / East athwart the head of Mr Hatchers run towards the / Ashen Swamp one hundred and forty Chaines and from thence / South South East two hundred & forty Chaines to the place / where it began the said Land being ded unto the said Xtopher / Robinson & John Sturdevant by and for the transportation / of twelve persons into this Colony etc to have and to hold etc / yeilding and paying etc which payment is to be made Seven / yeares after the first or deating thereof and not before provided / etc Dated the 23rd feby 1652 /
