To all &c Whereas &c Know yee &c I Nath: Bacon Esq Presid &c give and grant unto / Matthew Marks five hundred fifty six acres of land lying & being in Martin Brandon / parish in Charles City Com. bounded as foll: beginning at a corner gum neer Wards run and / thence upp a line of old markt trees of yee lands late of Edward Richards South fourty four deg: / east one hundred forty eight chains (each chain two statute pole) to a corner white oke thence / by another line of ye same lands So: West one hundred and nineteen chains Nor: West forty chains / & West forty one degr: South eighty nine chains & a half to a gum. thence by a line of ye lands given of / Wm Blighton So: by East fifty five chain to a hicory. thence East ten deg: South one hundred & / twenty chain. North thirty two degr. east ninety nine chain North twenty five degr: West fifty / one chain, East thirty deg: North sixty seavoen chain. North thirty one deg: West fifty chain. / and West forty three deg: North seaventy one chaine to a markt white oke on ye side of / ye aforesaid Wards run thence upp along ye water cours of ye said Run to ye place where it / begun -- ye sd land being due to ye sd Marks by and for ye transportation of twel / persons &c to have & to hold &c to be held &c yeilding & paying &c Provided &c / dated Aprill 21 1690.
