Anne &c To All &c Know ye that for diverse good Causes and Considerations but more / especially for and in Consideration of the Sum of twenty Shillings of good & Lawful money for our use paid to our / Receiver General of our Revenues in this our Colony and Dominion of Virginia We have Given Granted & Confirm'd / and by these presents for us our heirs & successors do Give Grant and Confirme unto Matthew Markes of the County of Surry / one Certain Tract or parcel of land containing Two hundred acres lying and being on the south side of the main black / water Swamp in the County of Isle of Wight and bounded as followeth to wit, beginning at a Gum on the north East / side of a branch just above a forke: then north fourty eight degrees East fourty seven pole to a red oak then north fourty / degrees West Eighty six pole to a red oak then north seventy degrees west three & thirty pole to a red oak then north / fifty degrees West a hundred & four pole to Captain William Broward line then by his Lines South fifteen degrees / West thirty four pole to a red oak & south eighty four degrees West ninety pole to a White oak & south fourty seven / degrees West ninety four pole to a pine & West by South thirty five to a pine a Line Tree of Capt Browards / then South fifty degrees East eighty six pole to a pine then north seventy five degrees East fourty pole to a white oak / then East South east sixty eight pole to two pines then north fifty eight degrees East ninety eight pole to a red oak / just over the branch begun upon and up the Runn of that branch to the first station with all &c To have / hold &c To be held &c yielding & paying &c Provided &c / In Witness &c Witness our Trusty and Welbeloved Alexander Spotswood our Lt. Governor / esq. att Williamsburgh under the seal of our sd. Colony the sixteenth day of June In the thirteenth year of our Reign / and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fourteen.
