George &c. To all &c. Know Ye that for diverse good Causes and Considerations but more especially for & / in Consideration of the Importation of Seven persons to dwell within this our Colony of Virginia whose names are Matthew Markes, / Mary Markes, Edw. Markes, John Markes, Israel Markes, Sarah Markes, and Wm. Townsin do also for and in consideration / of the sum of ten Shillings of good & Lawful money for our use paid to our Receiver General of our Revenues in this our P. Colony We / have Given Granted and Confirmed and by these presents for us our heirs and successors do Give Grant and Confirm unto John Eaton of / the County of York one Certain Tract or parcel of Land containing four hundred and twenty nine acres lying and being in Prince / George County and bounded as followeth to wit, beginning at a White oak on the Southern Run in the Line of Capt. George Blayton / decd. thence along the sd. Blayton's Line and into the woods West twenty one and a half degrees South two hundred & forty one poles / to a Shrub oak thence South one hundred twenty eight poles to two oakes & a Pine near the head of a branch thence East twenty three / degrees South two hundred and ninety poles to a red oak on the East side of a branch thence Northe forty one degrees East one hundred / twenty six poles and an half to a red oak thence North twenty two degrees West sixty poles thence West twenty five degrees South / eight poles to a Line being the Corner of Ralph Hill thence West thirty seven degrees North sixty eight poles to the head of the / Southern Run or meadow thence down the same according to the several meanders thereof to the place where begun With all &c. / To have hold &c. To be held &c. Yielding & paying &c. Provided &c. In Wit= / ness &c. Witness our Trusty and Well beloved Alexander Spotswood our Lt. Governor at Wmsburgh under / the seal of our Colony the Twenty third day of December one thousand seven hundred and fourteen In the first year of our / Reign.
